This Friends Report is divided into 4 chapters.

Chapter 1 describes your temperaments and personalities. The issues described in Chapter 1 become particularly powerful if you have a close or long-lasting relationship. Idiosyncrasies or quirks in another person's personality do not bother us as much if our relationship is a casual one. For example, if one person is neat and tidy and the other is sloppy, this is more likely to become a concern if you depend on each other in a business partnership than if you are casual acquaintances.

Pay close attention to the issues described in Chapter 2 because these are the most important themes in your relationship. For example, if themes of open communication and friendliness are emphasized, then you can count on this relationship growing into a close, long-lasting friendship. However, if friendliness and harmony between you are hardly mentioned at all, your relationship will be a more formal, less personal one and you probably won't think of one another as close friends. Note also that the material in Chapter 2 is presented roughly in order of importance, so that the material presented at the beginning of Chapter 2 is the most powerful.

Chapter 4 describes issues in your relationship of less importance than those presented in Chapter 2. Chapter 3 describes situations and circumstances that arise over time if your relationship is a long-lasting one.

If a statement appears to contradict another statement, then your roles are likely to alternate. For example, a statement that Paul is more aggressive than John, and another statement stating that John is more aggressive than Paul, means that you alternate roles, with Paul sometimes being the leader and John being the follower, and sometimes just the opposite. Also, read the statements carefully, as it is likely that a careful reading will reveal different kinds of aggressiveness or areas in which the aggressiveness is likely to express itself.

To make the most of this report, combine this astrological analysis with other things that you know about each other. For example, if your relationship is strictly business-related and close, personal friendship is unimportant to both of you, then it will not concern you if there is little warmth in the relationship. However, a lack of warmth and sympathy, or a tendency to be critical and judgmental of one another, is a more serious problem in a parent-child relationship. You may also want to order a Natal Report for each of you. The Natal Report describes your individual traits. The material in Chapters 2, 3 and 4 of this report describes the dynamics of your relationship, but does not describe your individual natures.

Your birth chart interpretation is based on the positions of the planets at the time of your birth. For the benefit of students of astrology, these positions, along with other technical information, are listed below:

Chapter 1

**A Comparison of Temperaments and Life Styles
that Affect Your Ability to Harmonize with Each Other**

Paul's Sun in Gemini and John's Sun in Libra:

You have an excellent mental rapport, and you enjoy one another's intelligence, wit, and style. Both of you are very social creatures who thrive on interaction with people,

cultural activities and conversation.

John is very considerate, has a strong desire to please Paul (or any friend) and will compromise readily; John always sees numerous possibilities or desirable alternatives, and you both have trouble being decisive or making up your minds sometimes.

Paul's Moon in Leo and John's Moon in Capricorn:

John's essentially sober, conservative, and cautious disposition contrasts with Paul's exuberant, generous, dramatic temperament. Paul's tastes are lavish, bold, and colorful, while John prefers a subdued, simple, quietly elegant style.

Whereas John downplays emotions and emotional displays, Paul often exaggerates them. Like a child, Paul is eager for attention, love, praise, and recognition from others, while John, ever the adult, rarely admits needing people in that way. John is, or appears to be, more self-sufficient emotionally. While Paul is usually quite warm and personable, John is frequently detached, formal, and businesslike with people. For John, sharing is shown by dedication and faithfulness or by practical assistance - "actions, not words", and Paul sometimes craves more warm attention from a friend.

Also, Paul is more of an optimist by nature, whereas John tends towards pessimism or at least a clear-eyed realism. Paul's cheerfulness can lighten John's mood when John becomes too serious (which is frequently).

Moon & Neptune hard for Paul, soft or conj for John:

Both of you are sensitive souls and are easily hurt by the harshness and abrasive aspects of the world. You share a compassionate, sympathetic feeling for others' suffering, and you emotionally and psychically "pick up on" whatever is happening in your environment, including other people's unspoken emotions. All of this is apt to be more confusing and overwhelming for Paul at times, whereas John is less likely to lose perspective.

There is also a mystical, imaginative, dreamy quality to both of you. Learning to use your imagination, fantasies, and sensitivity in a creative way (instead of just living in a make-believe world) is a challenge, especially for Paul. John's musical, artistic, or creative gifts can inspire and draw out Paul's talents along these lines.

Mars & Pluto hard or conj for Paul, soft for John:

Both of you can be very passionate and driven, and work or achievement can become an obsession for you. Whenever a desire makes itself felt in either of you, tremendous energy is released and you will pour yourself wholeheartedly, even compulsively, into fulfilling it - sometimes to the detriment of your health, relationships, or other areas of your lives. Using force and will appropriately, is easier for John than for Paul. When Paul's will or desires are blocked, Paul is prone to become intensely angry, and possibly

destructive. Paul wrestles with the destructive side of anger, and may fear anger and/or claiming personal power. The tendency to block rage and the necessity of learning to release it in constructive ways is one of Paul's lessons - something John may well be able to help with.

Chapter 2

Major Themes in the Relationship: What Brought You Together

Paul's Asc. Opposition John's Mars:

You enjoy working together and it is also likely that you engage in competitive sports or games with each other. A negative possibility is that one of you would attempt to dominate the other, causing anger and resentment in the other. You antagonize one another at times by emphasizing your individual differences and your own needs, rather than trying to cooperate or harmonize with one another. You bring out the fighter in each other. You are able to get issues out in the open, but direct confrontation can degenerate into attack if you are not careful. Be gentler with each other!

Paul's Mars Conjunction John's Pluto:

You draw out of each other your deepest drives and desires. The two of you arouse a zeal and sense of mission in each other that makes it possible for you to jointly accomplish extraordinary tasks. However, your fears and anxieties are brought to the surface too, and there is no guarantee that your zealousness will produce positive, constructive results. You may become fanatical in an extreme and unbalanced manner. Also, jealousy and competition can be very volatile, disruptive, obsessive, and intense in this relationship.

Paul's Sun Square John's Neptune:

You must guard against mutual deception and misunderstandings. Paul tends to have an unrealistic view of John, and John has a tendency to unconsciously capitalize on Paul's imaginative and often simply erroneous perceptions. The tendency to be dishonest, hide things from each other, exaggerate, and spur each other to unrealistic hopes and dreams is very strong. Both of you must be able to distinguish fantasy from fact, and utilize the increased sensitivity and heightened imagination that you inspire in each other, without letting it cloud your ability to clearly and realistically see other and understand each other.

John's Sun Trine Paul's Mercury:

The mental rapport that you two share is a big reason why you enjoy each other's company and are good friends. Communication is open and harmonious. You work

together very well on practical affairs, daily chores, problem-solving, and business activities.

John's Asc. Trine Paul's Mercury:

You work together very harmoniously on daily tasks and you can communicate very clearly and openly to each other. You "speak the same language" and you have a knack for quickly understanding each other.

Paul's Moon Square John's Jupiter:

You enjoy joking and kidding each other, and you spark each other's sense of humor. In fact, it is sometimes difficult to be serious with each other; the tendency to be light-hearted and jovial is too irresistible. Also, you are very supportive and encouraging to each other, but you tend to be overly optimistic about each other and make promises that you cannot fulfill. You encourage each other to be extravagant, sometimes too much so.

Paul's Moon Square John's Saturn:

This relationship is not an easy one! There is a sense of responsibility towards each other that may encourage you to work together on practical, mundane, or tedious tasks together. However, you both feel emotionally constrained and inhibited by being together, and this relationship may feel like a form of imprisonment! Paul, in particular, may feel disheartened by John's criticisms, worries, fears, or need to dominate Paul's life. Paul's emotional needs and feelings are ignored and neglected at times. Most likely there is too much emphasis on responsibilities and obligations. The serious tone of the relationship also stifles play and light-hearted fun-loving activities. This relationship may endure even when your feelings towards one another have cooled because there is a great deal of stability in it and reliability and responsibility to each other, even if there is little satisfaction over time.

John's Moon Trine Paul's Neptune:

You spark each other's imagination and you enjoy a colorful, sensitive relationship. Sharing of inner experiences, artistic and musical interests is likely to be a strong, positive part of your relationship, and you may engage in positive artistic, musical, or altruistic endeavors together.

John's Venus Square Paul's Saturn:

Feelings of estrangement, distance, coolness, or lack of appreciation and affection characterize your relationship from time to time, and John in particular feels inhibited or criticized by Paul. You take your commitment, responsibility, and obligations to one another seriously and you may depend heavily on one another financially or emotionally, but you tend to become too formal and rather joyless if you spend too much time together.

John's Venus Square Paul's Uranus:

Excitability, spontaneity, getting a bit loose or crazy together and acting on impulse are highlighted in your relationship. You may have an on again/off again type of relationship, somewhat unpredictable or unconventional or unstable, but it can be a great deal of fun. Negatively, both of you tend to be unreliable toward the other, and unwilling to forego personal desires or freedom for the sake of the other. Much flexibility and tolerance are required of both of you in order to bring out the best of each other in this relationship.

John's Venus Sextile Paul's Jupiter:

The two of you enjoy a high level of harmony, good will, and enthusiasm. You invariably have an enjoyable time together: you have many friends, and you enjoy socializing and going out together. Traveling or vacationing together works out very happily for you. Financial and material benefits may also result for you both through this relationship.

John's Mars Square Paul's Jupiter:

The two of you enjoy planning and designing methods for achieving success. You encourage each other to achieve your dreams and Paul frequently points out new avenues and grander vistas for John's talents and energy. However, the propensity to speculation and unrealistic optimism is also very strong, and many of your joint ventures are likely to prove wasteful, poorly timed, or extravagant.

John's Mars Trine Paul's Saturn:

You can work together very effectively, focusing your energy and attention on the tasks at hand. John feels that Paul will stand behind John's efforts and be a solid supporter, and Paul's experience or practicality is often a help to John.

John's Mars Trine Paul's Uranus:

An electric, exciting quality infuses your relationship and you encourage one another to be bold, confident, and assertive. Vigorous physical activities, like sports, are good outlets for the vital dynamic energy you generate together. Your unusual, original, unconventional impulses emerge when you are together, also.

Paul's Mars Sextile John's Mars:

You are able to work together very harmoniously and complement each other's efforts. You coordinate well on tackling daily chores and you are able to accomplish a great deal in almost any joint effort. A friendly rivalry spurs you both on in your individual efforts, also.

Chapter 3

Destiny and Final Outcome of Your Relationship

Composite Moon Square Pluto:

When you are together, deep emotions and intense, compelling, irrational energies within both of you come into play. Definitely, if you are friends for any length of time, you will both undergo an emotional transformation, a soul cleansing, for being together will dredge up all of your unfinished emotional business and feelings you may not even have believed yourselves capable of.

A significant part of your purpose in coming together is to clear up and heal the past - old griefs, jealousies, wounds, and unresolved emotions, many of which you may have forgotten about until now!

Certainly, no matter how long this relationship lasts, it will be a profound, intense one. Emotionally it may feel overwhelming at times. If any emotional manipulation, domination, or abuse occurs, you both need to step back and get a clear, objective third party to help you. At times you're both apt to feel that you're in over your heads. On the other hand, though you may go through extreme emotions, you can develop an incredibly close bond.

Composite Mercury Square Uranus:

There is an electric, intellectual quality to your friendship. You'll be continually challenging or upsetting one another's ways of seeing the world, provoking each other to THINK and to remain mentally alert, active, and awake. One of you is apt to be considerably more liberal, progressive, "radical", and interested in unconventional or alternative concepts and methods than the other, who finds this both fascinating and unsettling.

When you are together you tend to speak before you really ponder what you are saying, and the intellectual give and take between you can be rather dazzling. You may feel more brilliant and quick-witted with one another than you do with other people. However, you will also find one another's company to be nerve-wracking and not very relaxing a lot of the time.

You are great for one another when it comes to brainstorming, stimulating original thinking and inspiring one another intellectually - and that is at least part of what this relationship is for.

Composite Sun Square Saturn:

The necessity to get down to business, to work hard, and to be responsible adults is an essential aspect of your alliance. When you are together a sense of heaviness, seriousness, purpose, or obligation weighs in on you, so it is not always pleasant to be around one another. One or both of you may become overly critical, oppressive, and restrictive toward the other. You may face or become involved in difficulties which require patience, endurance, forbearance, and toughness. Part of the purpose of this relationship is to develop these qualities within you both. While unlikely to be an easy relationship, it can be character-building and ultimately strengthening.

Composite Moon Sextile Mars:

You have an active, energizing relationship, one that enables you both to express your emotions very directly and openly. Whatever friction you do experience, are not due to emotional stagnation or boredom.

Inevitably there will be emotional outbursts and honest, naked expressions of feeling. You enjoy noisy, rambunctious, lively activities together.

When you join forces, you are more competitive, outgoing and active than either of you may be individually.

Composite Mercury Conjunct Mars:

Vigorous debates and intellectual sparring will inevitably play a key role in your friendship. What you might try to convey tactfully in other circumstances, you will state directly and unequivocally with each other. This can lead to numerous arguments and disputes, not so much due to deep differences of opinion but simply due to the way you both communicate with one another.

It is likely that one or both of you will come to feel verbally attacked, or criticized for petty things, unless you both are willing to work on being gentler with each other.

On the other hand, if you enjoy bantering, competing intellectually, and hotly debating various issues, you may not consider any of this a problem. It will, however, be an ongoing dynamic in the way you relate to one another.

Composite Mars Square Uranus:

An intense quality of impatience, and an inability to wait, or restrain or thoughtfully consider your actions, are innate aspects of this friendship. "I want what I want and I want it NOW!" is the feeling you will both have. There is an impulsive, rebellious, daredevilish, I-can-do-whatever-I-want quality which infuses your relationship with excitement but also makes it unpredictable and unstable. If either of you has a problem with temper or a tendency toward violence, unfortunately this will be acted out in sudden and erratic ways. Even if you don't have these tendencies, you two can be dangerous

together because you make one another reckless. You can be wild and free together -but also very defiant and easily provoked.

Composite Saturn Trine Neptune:

Even if you know one another only casually, you will find that you talk quite easily about what is really important in your lives, as well as what is hindering you or troubling you.

You can help one another meet and overcome problems. One of you may view the other as a teacher, guide, or coach in times of trouble.

Topics of a religious or spiritual nature eventually arise, and you help each other clarify your values, goals, and dreams.

Chapter 4

Other Themes in Your Relationship

Paul's Sun in John's 9th house:

John takes a great interest in Paul's philosophical or religious outlook on life, and Paul often assumes the role of teacher or mentor towards John.

John's Sun in Paul's 7th house:

Although you have opposite personalities in some ways, you complement each other well and both of you learn from having a friend who is strong in areas where you are weak, and who brings out your strengths also.

Paul's Moon in John's 10th house:

Paul takes a great interest in John's career and reputation, and is likely to openly promote John's career, drawing recognition to John and "advertising" John's services and talents.

John's Moon in Paul's 11th house:

You share a light-hearted, outgoing, friendly relationship. The friendly feeling of camaraderie that you share makes your relationship enjoyable and fun. You tend to avoid topics of inner, personal concern with each other, and the mood is usually light, breezy, friendly, but not particularly warm and personal.

Paul's Mercury in John's 8th house:

Your conversations are rarely superficial, and the intensity and depth of your conversations may have been an important factor in drawing the two of you into a relationship. You are also likely to develop joint business ventures or financial strategies.

John's Mercury in Paul's 7th house:

Your conversations are lively. It seems that both of you can't resist a debate with each other. Although you frequently disagree with each, fortunately you enjoy the lively exchange of ideas nevertheless. You consult with one another in order to get an objective opinion and listener.

Paul's Venus in John's 8th house:

Paul is fascinating and almost mysterious to John. A deep, but emotionally complex relationship can easily develop.

John's Venus in Paul's 6th house:

Paul sees John as a person who is ready and willing to help with any problems that arise. John is a dependable friend that Paul can count on.

Paul's Mars in John's 10th house:

Paul aggressively promotes John's career goals and ambitions, becoming one of John's greatest "fans" and supporters. Paul may, however, become too pushy, demanding, and critical of John. Paul can become impatient with John, and turn 180 degrees, becoming John's greatest critic instead of supporter.

John's Mars in Paul's 7th house:

John has a "take charge" attitude towards this relationship and comes across very strong, perhaps aggressively, at times. Paul appreciates John's direct, uninhibited approach to Paul, but there is a tendency to become combative and competitive with each other at times.

Paul's Jupiter in John's 9th house:

There is much variety and expansiveness in this friendship. You enjoy planning for the future and expanding horizons together. You enjoy traveling, vacationing, and socializing together. The rich variety of experiences that you share together enriches your outlook on life and increases your appreciation of many things that you otherwise tend to be unaware of or uninvolved in. Paul will expand John's world considerably. If you are involved in a joint business venture, you are likely to sometimes ignore important details in your zeal to expand.

John's Jupiter in Paul's 1st house:

John puts Paul in an optimistic, fun-loving, outgoing, mood. You like to go out, travel, and have fun together. John is also generous towards Paul and freely gives gifts and assistance to Paul. You enjoy planning and scheming together and sometimes you get a bit overly optimistic in your shared hopes and dreams.

Paul's Saturn in John's 8th house:

The two of you should not pool your assets or enter into financial transactions together, as this is likely to strain your friendship considerably. John in particular may feel unhappy or dissatisfied with this arrangement.

John's Saturn in Paul's 1st house:

John's more mature, responsible, reliable side comes out in this relationship. John becomes almost paternalistic toward Paul, and John is inclined to offer lots of advice, sometimes being critical, judgmental, and interfering too much with Paul's plans and goals. John's "helpful criticism" sometimes sours into moralistic judgments. John should be wary of the tendency to control Paul and severely limit Paul's freedom.

Paul's Uranus in John's 8th house:

The way you jointly handle finances and investments is likely to take some unusual turns and the two of you may, for example, invest in some risky ventures. Any joint investments or pooling of your assets will bring surprises and possibly upsets, especially to John.

John's Uranus in Paul's 2nd house:

John encourages Paul to use more creative, unusual methods for investing, developing financial stability and security. John may, for example, encourage Paul to invest in a new enterprise that presents big opportunities but is also risky.

Paul's Neptune in John's 11th house:

You are likely to become involved in social groups, political or altruistic organizations, committees, and religious groups together. A big challenge will be how to maintain a high level of integrity and honesty in these activities so that the ideals can be reached.

John's Neptune in Paul's 6th house:

Paul is often disappointed in the way that John handles problems and performs various chores and tasks. Paul is likely to feel that John is careless or sloppy. This is not likely to create any serious problems, unless you work together.

Paul's Pluto in John's 10th house:

If this is a long-term relationship, Paul will have a critical effect on John's career and ambitions. Circumstances arise that enable Paul to play a key role in helping steer John's career along new lines and to levels of greater stature and influence. Paul can help John gain a whole new outlook on career opportunities and the best way to utilize his/her own talents, but this process is a complex and tricky one, and the final outcome could be very successful or a failure, depending on how both of you handle the situation.

John's Pluto in Paul's 5th house:

John may profoundly influence Paul's creativity and self-expression. John helps Paul express hidden feelings, talents, and interests.

Paul's Asc. Opposition John's Neptune:

It is very likely that you do not see one another clearly and objectively; misunderstanding, poor communication, and a general fog may surround your interaction with one another. Negatively, you may reinforce one another's weaknesses, passivity, or dependencies. Positively, you can encourage one another's spiritual quests or aspirations.

Paul's Asc. Trine John's Pluto:

John can be "the power behind the throne" when it comes to Paul's ambitions and aspirations, or John may set the agenda with Paul carrying out John's will and desires. Paul's confidence, personal effectiveness, and social influence is greatly enhanced by John's presence and encouragement.

John's Moon Opposition Paul's Mars:

Both of you get into an energetic mood when you are together. If you share an interest in the same sport (for example tennis or golf) you will enjoy competing against each other. However, you easily become impatient with each other and easily provoke each other's anger and hostility. You will need to be careful to avoid becoming adversaries.

Paul's Moon Square John's Mercury:

John needs to guard against the tendency to be critical, unsympathetic, and overly analytical of Paul's feelings, personal tastes, and habits. John may feel that Paul is overly sensitive to criticism, and refuse to acknowledge responsibility for the problem as well. Petty annoyances, minor disagreements, and bickering can be avoided only if you both learn to listen sympathetically and to communicate clearly with each other.

John's Moon Trine Paul's Uranus:

There is an upbeat, enthusiastic, spontaneous quality to your relationship. You spark each other's imagination, creativity, and wit. You feel loose and uninhibited with each other, and you enjoy exploring life and sharing new experiences.

John's Mercury Square Paul's Pluto:

Your conversations have a deep, probing quality. There is a strong tendency to attempt to coerce each other to understand your point of view and agree with you. Paul may attempt to dominate John's thinking, or radically alter John's view of things.

Paul's Venus Conjunct John's Jupiter:

You enjoy each other's company immensely and you put each other in a happy mood. You make each other laugh and you feel very open, loose, and jovial around each other. There is a great deal of generosity between you, and you may benefit one another financially and materially as well as emotionally. A wonderful friendship!

John's Mars Sextile Paul's Pluto:

Bonding is strong and the two of you are able to work together effectively in achieving goals and objectives. If you share a similar hobby or profession, you can jointly develop creative works of high quality - a result of your combined dedication. As your relationship deepens, you will find that the two of you are able to assist each other immensely in achieving the goals and objectives that are most meaningful and important to you.

Paul's Saturn Sextile John's Pluto:

The two of you can be a very disciplined, focused, dedicated team, working towards realizing some ambition. You help one another achieve your deepest life purposes, and if either or both of you is a workaholic, that will be reinforced by the other.

John's Uranus Trine Paul's Neptune:

You are more open and receptive to the psychic realm and to spiritual impulses when you are together, and you may explore areas such as telepathy, dreams, meditation, and "higher consciousness" to a greater degree than ever before. You inspire imagination and creativity along artistic or musical lines in one another as well.
